CHRISTMAS

DAY 12: ALL HUMAN BEINGS ARE FREE AND EQUAL



Action: Choose a group you feel connected to and share a note in the spirit of brotherly or sisterly love.

DAY 11: NO DISCRIMINATION

Action: Write a note on your favourite social media platform about a discrimination you've witnessed and wish to change.



DAY 10: NO TORTURE AND INHUMANE TREATMENT

Action: Find 2 examples of inhumane treatment, one by the government of your country and one of another country.

DAY 09: EQUAL BEFORE THE LAW

Action: Find a similar legal case or situation where 2 different people of a different race or gender were not treated the same before the law.



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DAY 08: NO UNFAIR DETAINMENT

Action: Find a case of someone in your region who has been illegally detained and is still fighting to be freed. Determine what you can do to help.

DAY 07: INNOCENT UNTIL PROVEN GUILTY

Action: Make a list of police actions that enable the illegal detention of someone who has yet to be proven guilty. ie. no knock warrant



DAY 06: FREEDOM TO MOVEMENT AND RESIDENCE



DAY 05: RIGHT TO MARRY AND TO FOUND A FAMILY

Action: Find an example of a new law or mandate that does not protect the family but rather attacks one's right to build, support and care for the unit.





DAY 4: FREEDOM OF EXPRESSION

Action: Find a current example of someone being cancelled, penalized or defamed for holding a minority opinion and seeking to impart information freely.

DAY 03: FREEDOM OF ASSEMBLY

Action: Read about the Freedom convoy in Canada and determine if the truckers were denied their rights and not allowed to assemble freely.





DAY 02: RIGHT TO WORK

Action: Research and find a group of people in your community being underpaid. Reach out and ask them how you may be able to help bring awareness to their cause.

DAY 01: RIGHT TO EDUCATION

Action: Determine what existing laws hinders children's right to an education and/or fail to strengthen the respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms in it's curriculum.
